Dear Parent/Carers

We received last Thursday the guidance from the Government on how to open more fully in September. We have been working hard over the last few days to respond to this by looking at all the ways to minimise the risk of the virus being caught or spread whilst being able to deliver lessons. For this to happen the routines of the school day will look different however it will mean we will warmly welcome all students back, full time, in September from the first day of term. I will communicate with you again on Tuesday with more finalised details on what time and day your son/daughter needs to be in school and where they need to go.

Some parents, quite rightly, are keen to know what uniform and equipment to buy in good time for students returning to the Academy. We are pleased to say that students will be wearing their full school uniform every day; it will be great to see them looking smart, fully equipped and ready to learn. There are no changes to the school uniform for this academic year although we will be reviewing all aspects of the uniform during the course of the year. Any changes that will be made will be come into effect in the autumn of 2021. Please do remind yourself of the uniform list which is available on the school website and if you are buying a school skirt please make sure that it is a 'Q' skirt from our suppliers and that it reaches the knee. Shoes must be black with no sports branding of any kind. Initially, PE lessons will be taking place with students being active (playing rounders etc.) but not changing into kit other than trainers and removing ties. Nonetheless, each student will need a full PE kit once restrictions are lifted and we are able to return to our usual arrangements. They will also need a school bag that can hold their schools books for the day as it is likely they will be not leaving their school books in school as before. They also need 2 pencils, 2 pens, a ruler and a calculator in a pencil case.

I hope you are all keeping well. As I have said, I will write to you again next week.
